## Open Space Project Description

**Sept 2010 to Sept 2013**

**The Big Lottery People & Places Fund**

### **Project Objectives: -**

1. Improve the physical, mental and emotional health and wellbeing of women and girls
2. Increase the knowledge, confidence, social networks and skills of girls and women
3. Increase the level of cohesion and understanding between community groups
4. Increased availability of community facilities to those living in the Butetown/Grangetown area

### **Project Outcomes over the three years: -**

- 6 Community cohesion events (2 per year)
- 75 young women aged 13-17 engaged with the project
- 144 women engaged with the project
- 15 community groups utilising the building

### **Project Target Groups**

- Women and families
- Young girls aged 13-17

### **Project Management: -**

The day-to-day management of the project will be the responsibility of the Director.

### **Project Description**

The project will extend the facilities and activities available in the local community to a wider range of groups. It will focus on the development of the local community, particularly in the adjoining wards of Butetown and Grangetown. The project will deliver opportunities during the evenings, school holidays and at weekends allowing us to cater for family groups, employed women and young girls.

In particular for young girls aged 13-17 it will provide both recreational and educational activities. These will run as a number of programmes through the school holidays

- 3 x 3 day programmes running during each of the half terms
- 1 x 10 day programme running during the summer holidays
- 1 x 5 day programme running during the Easter holidays

At weekends and evenings the project will work with community groups, families and individuals to identify, plan and deliver relevant learning activities.

The project will also provide support to community groups by providing a venue for their activities.
